# TIPS FROM YOUR COUNSELORS

- Don't skip class! Make sure to pass everything, it will make your second semester SO much less stressful

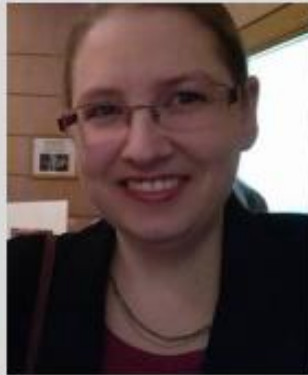


